Starting from 20 February 2012, MENDAKI invites Muslim students with high academic potential to vie for its range of scholarships and bursary. Application for the following scholarships and bursary will be opened till 24 March 2012.

Yayasan MENDAKI Scholarship (Polytechnic)

Introduced in 1995, the Yayasan MENDAKI Scholarship (Polytechnic) aims to reward aspiring students with the intention of pursuing diploma courses at any of the local government polytechnics, namely Ngee Ann Polytechnic, Nanyang Polytechnic, Singapore Polytechnic, Temasek Polytechnic and Republic Polytechnic.

Yayasan MENDAKI - Merchant Scholarship

With the objective of encouraging students to continue to do well in their studies at the local polytechnics, the scholarship was mooted in August 2006 by philanthropists Mr Aziz Merchant and Dr Reshma Merchant, with the support of MENDAKI.

Special Malay Bursary (SMB) - Polytechnic

Administered by the Public Service Commission (PSB) then, the administration of the SMB has been taken over by MENDAKI since 1995. First year Malay students who are already enrolled in any of the 5 local polytechnics, namely Nanyang Polytechnic, Ngee Ann Polytechnic, Republic Polytechnic, Singapore Polytechnic and Temasek Polytechnic are welcomed to apply.
