NEW LEADERSHIP IN MENDAKI CLUB

A new 15-member Executive Committee (EXCO) begins a two-year term at MENDAKI Club (MClub) today, following the conclusion of MClub's 13th Annual General Meeting. The 7th committee will comprise seven members from the previous EXCO and eight new members. (Refer to the Annex for the list of new EXCO members).

2 The new EXCO will build on MClub's existing mission to be a leading youth community organisation of young Malay/Muslim professionals, excelling in youth leadership and capability development.

3 Mr Jeffrey Salleh, 37, will serve as the new President. Mr Jeffrey is a Senior Manager at Oracle R&D (Asia). He has served in the MClub EXCO since 2011 and was a speaker at the MClub Graduates' Tea in 2009. He has also been involved with Muslim Converts' Association of Singapore, also known as Darul Arqam, since 2005. He completed his degree with First Class Honors in Network Computing in 2001. He was also awarded the "ASEAN Rising Star Award" in 2010 by the US-ASEAN Business Council.

4 Ms Noor Atiqah Halim, 32, will serve as Vice President. Ms Noor Atiqah is currently a civil servant with the Public Service Division. She has served in the MClub EXCO since 2011 as an Assistant Treasurer. She has been a volunteer with MENDAKI since 2000 and has also been involved in MClub activities since 2009, overseeing events such as the Graduates' Tea and Collegiate Symposium. She is also a member of the Media Development Authority's Malay Programme Advisory Committee since 2009.

5 Mr Mohamed Idris Bin Mohamed Haniffa, 36, an Educator at Millennia Institute, will be the Secretary. Mr Adam Hashidy, 38 is a Vice President, Energy Marketing at Mitsui. He will be the Treasurer. Both men also served in the previous EXCO.

6 Ms Nur Dian Bte Mohamad Rasid, 28, will step down as MClub President. She has been involved in MClub activities from 2007 and has held two key positions in the MClub EXCO in 2009/2011 and 2011/2013. She has been a mentor under MENDAKI's Youth In Action (YIA) and Empowerment Programme for Girls (EPG) from 2009. Apart from volunteering with MENDAKI, she is also part of People's

Association Teenage Network (T-Net) Advisory Committee as a Secretary. In 2010, she was awarded MENDAKI's Outstanding Youth Volunteer award as well as the Australian High Commission Outstanding Young Alumni award.
