MENDAKI Club (MClub) and Young AMP will be jointly organizing the 3rd run of PRAXIS which returns from Friday, 14th June 2013 to Monday, 17th June 2013 at the National Community Leadership Institute (NACLI).

PRAXIS is a collaborative project by MENDAKI Club and Young AMP to engage the young to instill greater social and community consciousness, as well as cultivate critical and creative thinking on core issues of the day. The conception of **PRAXIS** was announced by Dr Yaacob Ibrahim, the then Minister of Information, Communications and the Arts and Minister in-charge of Muslim Affairs in his Hari Raya Speech in September 2010.

'Ubuntu – I Am Because We Are' is the spirited tagline of this year's PRAXIS which depicts the idea of how a community is shaped because of an individual and in turn, how every individual is shaped because of the community. For this year's residential workshop, the main highlight will be the development of **The PRAXIS Paper** which will require the participants to envision the future of the Malay/Muslim community of Singapore and identify their roles in shaping the future.

Beyond the residential workshop, selected participants may choose to continue with a follow-up 8-week program to work with others to develop concrete project ideas for the community.

This event will include a panel session featuring esteemed speakers including Assoc Prof Muhammad Faishal Ibrahim (Parliamentary Secretary, Ministry of Health & Ministry of Transport), Dr Shamsuri Juhari (RIMA), Mr Ibnur Rashad (Sustainable Living Lab), Mr Shafie Abdullah (YouthReach), Mr Jeffrey Salleh (President, MENDAKI Club) and Mr Saktiandi Supaat (Young AMP).
