NEW CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AT YAYASAN MENDAKI

1. Ms Tuminah Sapawi will be appointed as Chief Executive Officer (CEO)-designate of Yayasan MENDAKI on 18 November 2013. The current CEO, Mdm Moliyah Hashim, was seconded to Yayasan MENDAKI from the Ministry of Education (MOE) on 1 January 2010 and will return to MOE on 16 December 2013. Ms Tuminah will take over as CEO upon Mdm Moliyah's return to MOE.
2. During her four-year term, Mdm Moliyah sharpened MENDAKI's focus to reach out to and provide more holistic help to families in need. She spearheaded programmes such as Enhanced Wrap-Around Care (eWAC), Mendaki@Heartlands and SENSE College, to lend more families the skills and assistance needed to uplift their lives. Under her stewardship, MENDAKI has also stepped up efforts to help promising youths achieve many peaks of excellence, through initiatives such as Project Protégé and the Ridzwan Dzafir Community Awards.
3. Mdm Moliyah has contributed much to the Malay/Muslim community, handing over a stronger MENDAKI to her successor, Ms Tuminah. MENDAKI Chairman and Board of Directors would like to thank Mdm Moliyah for her dedicated commitment in the past four years.
4. Ms Tuminah will be seconded from the Ministry of Social and Family Development (MSF) to MENDAKI. She served in the Family Strengthening Branch of MSF's ComCare and Social Support Division for five years prior to taking up this appointment.
