MALAY/MUSLIM SELF-HELP GROUP YAYASAN MENDAKI APPOINTS FIRST CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER

1. Yayasan MENDAKI is pleased to announce the appointment of Mdm Zulaiha Yusuf as its first Chief Operating Officer (COO) with effect from 1 June 2015. This is a new appointment aimed at strengthening MENDAKI's strategic approach towards its core focus in Education.
