YAYASAN MENDAKI EDUCATION SYMPOSIUM – NURTURING YOUNG LEARNERS TOWARDS A FUTURE READY GENERATION

How do we cultivate our young children to be enthusiastic lifelong learners, prepared for future challenges? This question, along with other issues on early childhood learning and development, will be discussed at the inaugural MENDAKI Education Symposium on Saturday, 29 April at SMU School of Law. Innovative and creative discussions such as interpreting children's drawings as well as how technology-enabled toys can support learning will be among the areas of focus.

As part of Yayasan MENDAKI's year-long activities and initiatives to <u>commemorate its</u> 35th <u>anniversary</u>, the Symposium serves as a platform to share, inform and discuss the pertinent issues affecting a young child's learning and development in relation to the Malay/Muslim community. Supported by the Early Childhood Development Agency (ECDA) and aligned to MOE's Nurturing Early Learner's Framework, the symposium also serves to <u>add value to national Early Learning Initiatives</u>. Topics ranging from Socio-Emotional Learning (SEL), to technology-enabled education for future readiness will be addressed. Through this platform, participants can also build partnership and support to enhance early childhood development within the Malay/Muslim community.

There will be two sessions which target primary stakeholders of Early Childhood Development in the community. The morning session, targets practitioners, professionals, community leaders and policy makers, will focus on the early childhood education landscape in Singapore by addressing themes like policies and teaching tools for a better learning environment. The afternoon session is open to parents and will

share ways to enrich their children's holistic development with tips such as effective mediation, wholesome nutrition and learning through play in the Digital Age.

Minister for Communications and Information, Minister-in-Charge of Cyber Security and Minister-in-Charge of Muslim Affairs, Dr Yaacob Ibrahim will be gracing the event as Guest-of-Honour.
